I will attempt to put into words my heartfelt gratitude to the many physicians who over the course of 15 or more years tried with all earnestness and compassion tried to free me from the most horrible and agonizing foot pain one could imagine. Several years of self medicating with drugs and alcohol just so I could sleep and doctors prescriptions to help me sleep but no cure. Finally after several epidurals my back doctor suggested I see Dr. Ford before possibly having to have lower back surgery (as we believed that could be the root cause for my foot pain) and after speaking to Dr. Ford he suggested I test for Tarsal Tunnel Syndrome. All I can say is that I truly love Dr. Ford (Bruce) and his staff for changing my life in so many ways by just doing what they do.
